

## What's changed, Mitch McConnell? Democrats are ready to get to work.


## **DPCC REPORT: OCTOBER 2019**

Under McConnell's leadership, the Senate has been in working session <u>115 days</u> this year, of which <u>only 58</u> have been spent voting on legislation.

Through October 15, 2019, average Americans will have had <u>202</u> working days, nearly **FOUR TIMES** as many days as the Senate has voted on legislation.

Meanwhile, the House of Representatives has voted on more than <u>456 pieces of legislation and amendments</u>.

That's more than **SIX TIMES** the amount <u>the Senate has voted on</u> (71).



The Senate has taken no action—no debate, no votes, no amendments—on House-passed legislation addressing the issues on which the American people want action.
